ORDINANCE NO. 880

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PERSONS TO PICK UP AND REMOVE ANIMAL MANURE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood finds that the leaving of animal manure on public property or on private property not owned by the animal owner is detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare, and constitutes a nuisance and is unsightly, odorous, and burdens persons who are not responsible for the problem.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Every person who owns or who has under their control or care any animal shall be responsible for picking up and removing immediately any offal or manure left by any such animal upon any public place in the city or upon any private property not owned by him or her.

Section 2. Any person who owns or who has under their control or care any animal and who fails to pick up and remove immediately any offal or manure left by any such animal upon any public place in the City of Lynnwood or private property, not owned by him or her, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punished by fine not to exceed \$250.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
