

CITY OF LYNNWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 885

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 763 OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD WHICH ADOPTS THE 1973 UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, REPEALING ALL SECTIONS IN CONFLICT HERewith AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 401(a) of the Uniform Plumbing Code, 1973 Edition is hereby amended and updated by deleting:

Section 401--Materials

(a) Drainage pipe shall be cast iron, galvanized steel, galvanized wrought iron, lead, copper, brass, ABS, PVC or other approved materials having a smooth and uniform bore, except: 1. That no galvanized wrought iron or galvanized steel pipe shall be used underground and shall be kept at least six (6) inches above ground. 2. ABS or PVC installations limited to residential construction not more than two (2) stories in height.

AND INSERTING IN ITS PLACE THE FOLLOWING WORDING:

Section 401--Materials

(a) Drainage pipe shall be cast iron, galvanized steel, galvanized wrought iron, lead, copper, brass, ABS, PVC or other approved materials having a smooth and uniform bore, except: 1. That no galvanized wrought iron or galvanized steel pipe shall be used underground and shall be kept at least six (6) inches above ground. 2. ABS or PVC drain waste and vent, Schedule 40 pipe is approved for building occupancy classifications H, I and J for underground and above ground use up to 30 feet in height provided adequate support is provided at not to exceed 9' centers measured vertically. The 30 foot height limitation shall be calculated by measuring from the base of the stack at its lowest point to the ceiling of the uppermost story.

Section 2. That if any section, sentence, clause or phrase should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
