

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION BY CON-
DEMNATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND PROPERTY RIGHTS IN THE CITY
OF LYNNWOOD FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A STORM DRAINAGE RETENTION POND
TO BE FINANCED FROM THE STREET FUND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That public necessity and convenience deemed that
the City of Lynnwood acquire the fee title interest to the following
described parcel of real property, all in the City of Lynnwood, more
particularly described as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto
and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2: That such acquisition is hereby declared to be for
a public use and a part, addition and betterment to the Comprehensive
Storm Drainage Plan and System, heretofore adopted by the City of
Lynnwood and all costs of such acquisition shall be from the Street
Fund.


Section 3: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed
to prosecute the action and proceedings necessary in the manner pro-
vided by law, to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

January, 1977.
