

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

ORDINANCE NO. 907

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTY CLAUSE OF ORDINANCE NO. 874, WHICH PROHIBITS HORSES ON PARKING STRIPS AND SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood finds the penalty clause in Ordinance No. 874 to be unrealistic as it pertains to a jail sentence,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2, Ordinance No. 874, which reads as follows:

*Section 2: Penalty. Violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed \$500.000 or imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed 90 days, or by both fine and imprisonment.*

SHALL BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. Penalty. Violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


