

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

ORDINANCE NO. 933

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 1977 BUDGET, ADOPTED UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBER 886 BY INCREASING THE APPROPRIATIONS FROM FUNDS RECEIVED IN EXCESS OF ESTIMATED REVENUES, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY R.C.W. 35A.33.120, SECTION 4.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 1977 budget amount as authorized under Ordinance No. 886 for expenditures and revenues for the operation of the government of the City of Lynnwood for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1977, be amended and increased in the following amounts:

SECTION 2. That the budget for the year 1977 is amended to provide for the changes as outlined above, and filed in the office of the City Clerk, and is hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit this supplemental budget to the auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


