## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, adopting the 2021 Update of the Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan.

and

WHEREAS, the 2021 update of the Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan contains the required elements for such a plan as mandated

by state law, and said elements are important to the city's solid waste management activities;

WHEREAS, the update to the existing Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan was prepared in accordance with chapter 70.95 RCW, which requires that the City either adopt the county-wide plan or develop its own plan which must be approved by the Department of Ecology; and

WHEREAS, public input and comment was accepted through the development of the plan through various means and ways and the involvement of the Snohomish County Solid Waste Advisory Committee was the main organization associated with the development of the plan; and

WHEREAS, final adoption of the Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan by the Snohomish County Council and the Washington State Department of Ecology is contingent upon adoption of the Plan by the participating cities in Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best public interest to adopt and implement the 2021 update of the Snohomish County Comprehensive Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan: now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
