RESOLUTION NO. 76-16

A RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER VACATING A PORTION OF 60TH AVENUE WEST.

WHEREAS, circumstances have been brought to the attention of the Administration and the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, whereby it may be desirable for the City to vacate that certain public right-of-way known as 60th Avenue West between 208th Street Southwest and approximately the Pacific Northwest Traction Company right-of-way more specifically described as:

Beginning at the NW corner of Lot No. 1, Hillwood Park No. 7, Block 1, as recorded in Volume 16, Page 88 of Snohomish County Records; thence South to the SW corner of Lot 12, Hillwood Park No. 7, Block 1; thence West to the SE corner of Lot 8, Aurora Heights Division No. 2, as recorded in Volume 13, Page 7 of Snohomish County Records; thence North to the NE corner of Lot 13, Aurora Heights Division No. 2, thence West to the SE corner of Lot 14, Aurora Heights Division No. 2; thence North to the NE corner of Lot 14, Aurora Heights Division No. 2; thence East along the North line to the true point of beginning.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to call a public hearing for the purpose of considering the desirability of vacating said portion of said public right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, that 7:30 P.M. on September 13, 1976 in the Council Chambers of the City Hall at 19100-44th Avenue West be set as the date, time and place for hearing on the proposed vacation as described above.
