RESOLUTION NO. 76-20

A RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER VACATING A PORTION OF 181ST PLACE S.W.

WHEREAS, circumstances have been brought to the attention of the Administration and the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, whereby it may be desirable for the City to vacate that certain public right-of-way known as 181st Place S.W., east of 60th Avenue West, more specifically described as:

East 87.0 feet of the S 30 feet of the N 97.5 feet of the W 793 feet as measured along N line of Woodside Park, Vol. 34, page 1, Records of Snohomish County.


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to call a public hearing for the purpose of considering the desirability of vacating said portion of said public right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, that 7:30 P.M. on October 11, 1976 in the Council Chambers of the City Hall at 19100 - 44th Avenue West, Lynnwood, Washington, be set as the date, time and place for hearing on the proposed vacation as described above.
