RESOLUTION NO. 76-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR AN OUTDOOR RECREATION PROJECT TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION, AS PROVIDED BY THE MARINE RECREATION LAND ACT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the urban area which identifies a community park of approximately 20.0 acres on Scriber Lake in the center of the City as Number Two priority; and,

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act, State and Federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to and in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood considers it in the best public interest to acquire park land for a community park in the center of the City generally located adjacent to and south of S.R. 524 (196th Street Southwest) and between 52nd Avenue West and 56th Avenue West, all located in Lynnwood, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington,

1. That the Mayor be authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for fund assistance,
2. That any fund assistance so received be used in the acquisition of twenty (20) acres of land known as Scriber Lake in the center of the City of Lynnwood, Washington,
3. That any property developed with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected Federal agency, and
4. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.
