

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

RESOLUTION NO. 76-23

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE AMENDED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM CONCERNING THE ACQUISITION OF PARK LANDS, AND DEVELOPMENT THEREOF, WITHIN THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD.

WHEREAS, a Capital Improvement Program has been in effect, as periodically updated and revised, and has proven beneficial for sound financial and program planning; and

WHEREAS, a continuance of updating and revising of the Capital Improvement Program is a requirement for qualifying the City of Lynnwood for State and Federal financial assistance and project approval; and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Advisory Board has reviewed, approved and recommended the adoption of the amended Capital Improvement Program to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington

1. That the Five Year Capital Improvement Program dated June, 1968 as amended by the Ten Year Capital Improvement Program dated June, 1970, as amended by the Interim Six Year Capital Improvement Program, 1974 to 1980, dated April, 1974, be amended by the Interim Five Year Capital Improvement Program dated September 13, 1976,
2. That this plan and all amendments referred to above are hereby adopted by the City Council as recommended by the Park and Recreation Advisory Board and the Parks and Recreation Department staff,
3. That this be the progressive plan for acquisition and development of parks and recreation areas within the City of Lynnwood, and states the financial program for accomplishing the projects by priority,
4. That this plan be reviewed, and revised to the extent necessary in 1977, and each year thereafter to conform to and anticipate needs and availability of funding at that time, as well as changes in priority assignments to individual projects.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, at its regular meeting held the 13th day of September, 1976.
