RESOLUTION NO. 76-4

A RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER VACATING A PORTION OF 65TH AVENUE WEST.

WHEREAS, circumstances have been brought to the attention of the Administration and the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, whereby it may be desirable for the City to vacate that certain public right-of-way known as 65th Avenue West, between 210th Street S.W. and 212th Street S.W., more specifically described as:

Beginning at the southeast corner of vacated Block 7, of Seattle Heights Division No. 3, on page 39 of plats, volume 8, records of Snohomish County; said point being the true point of beginning; thence S 89°57'16" E a distance of 30.00 feet; thence N 2°30'31" W a distance of 604.30 feet; thence N 89°57'16" W a distance of 30.00 feet; thence S 2°30'31" E a distance of 604.30 feet back to the true point of beginning.


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to call a public hearing for the purpose of considering the desirability of vacating said portion of said public right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, that 7:30 P.M. on June 14, 1976 in the Council Chambers of the City Hall at 19100 - 44th Avenue West be set as the date, time and place for hearing on the proposed vacation as described above.


